A.A. in General Studies for PSEO

Crown College offers PSEO students an opportunity to obtain an Associate of Arts Degree in General Studies. Homeschool partner students would take hybrid and some strictly online classes. Hybrid courses would be offered through the homeschool using the Course Assistant model.

Although most of the courses are free through the PSEO program, students would need to pay for Bible courses, which are required by Crown, but not paid for by the State. To help offset some of the costs for Bible courses, Crown offers a number of competency based courses for free. An example program of study is below. Courses highlighted in light blue are free competency courses. Those highlight in yellow are paid for by the student.
