Covid Symptom Assessment

Please follow this protocol when evaluating your student's symptoms or exposure to covid-19.

Has your student been EXPOSED? How is exposure defined?

✓ To be considered "exposure," a student must have spent 15 minutes or more within 6 feet of an individual who tests positive for covid-19 with a health care provider. This contact must have occurred during the time when the infected individual was contagious. (An individual is considered contagious 48 hours prior to symptoms appearing and until cleared as indicated in chart below.)

What SYMPTOMS are relevant? Do not allow your student to attend class if:

- **1** of the following symptoms is present:
 - Fever of 100.4 or higher
 - A new cough
 - Difficulty breathing
- Or **2** of the following symptoms are present:
 - Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
 - New onset of sore throat
 - New onset of muscle aches
 - New loss of smell and taste
 - New onset of nasal congestion or runny nose
- ✓ We ask that you notify an administrator if your student has a positive diagnosis of covid-19 from a health care provider. All personal information will remain confidential. Thank you!
