What is PSEO?

1. State-approved courses
2. State-approved times
3. State-approved location
4. Paid for by the state of MN

What is Early College?

1. Any courses
2. Any semester 11th-12th grade
3. Any location
4. Paid for by the student

Admission Requirements (On-Site and Online):

1. High school GPA of 2.75
2. Standardized test scores:
 - ACT, PreACT, or Plan – 18
 - Aspire – 427
 - SAT or PSAT – 940
 - MAP – 235 Math, 222 Reading, and 222 Language Usage
 - Stanford Achievement, California Achievement, Terra Nova, Peabody, or Iowa Basics – top 50%

Application Deadlines:

July 15 – Fall Term

December 1 – Spring Term

April 15 – Summer Term (EC only)

Fall 2017 Dates for Online:

August 30 – December 21

September 13 – Add/Drop Deadline

November 10 – Withdrawal Deadline

Spring 2018 Dates for Online:

January 16 – May 17

January 29 – Add/Drop Deadline
